



Scottish air Quality Database and Website

- Harmonise and Standardise the data quality being produced by local authorities to better inform policy and improve air pollution.
- High quality comparable data that is easily accessible to all.
- Project officially launched April 2007 – c.50 monitoring sites in the database.
- February 2019 – 96 automatic sites.
- Supports the Cleaner Air for Scotland Strategy (CAFS), LAQM, research, public awareness etc.
- Helps to inform the Implementation of Scotland's Low Emissions Zones.


