Air Quality Management Area (No.5) Order, 2011

Falkirk Council, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 83(1) of the Environment Act 1995, hereby makes the following Order.

This Order may be referred to as the Falkirk Council Air Quality Management Area (No.5) Order 2011 and shall come into effect on 18th August 2011.

The area shown inside the solid black line on the map accompanying this Order is to be designated as an Air Quality Management Area ("the designated area").

The designated area is designated in relation to both i and ii:

- i. A breach of the particulate matter (PM_{10}) annual mean and 24 hour mean objectives as specified in the Air Quality (Scotland) (Amendment) Regulations 2002.
- ii. A potential breach of the particulate matter (PM_{10}) annual mean and 24 hour mean objectives as specified in the Air Quality (Scotland) Regulations 2000.


