Air Quality Management Area (No.4) Order 2010

Falkirk Council, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 83(1) of the Environment Act 1995, hereby makes the following Order.

This Order may be referred to as the Falkirk Council Air Quality Management Area (No.4) Order 2010 and shall come into effect on 18th March 2010.

The area shown inside the solid black line on the map accompanying this Order is to be designated as an Air Quality Management Area ("the designated area").

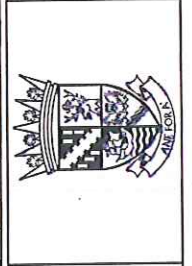
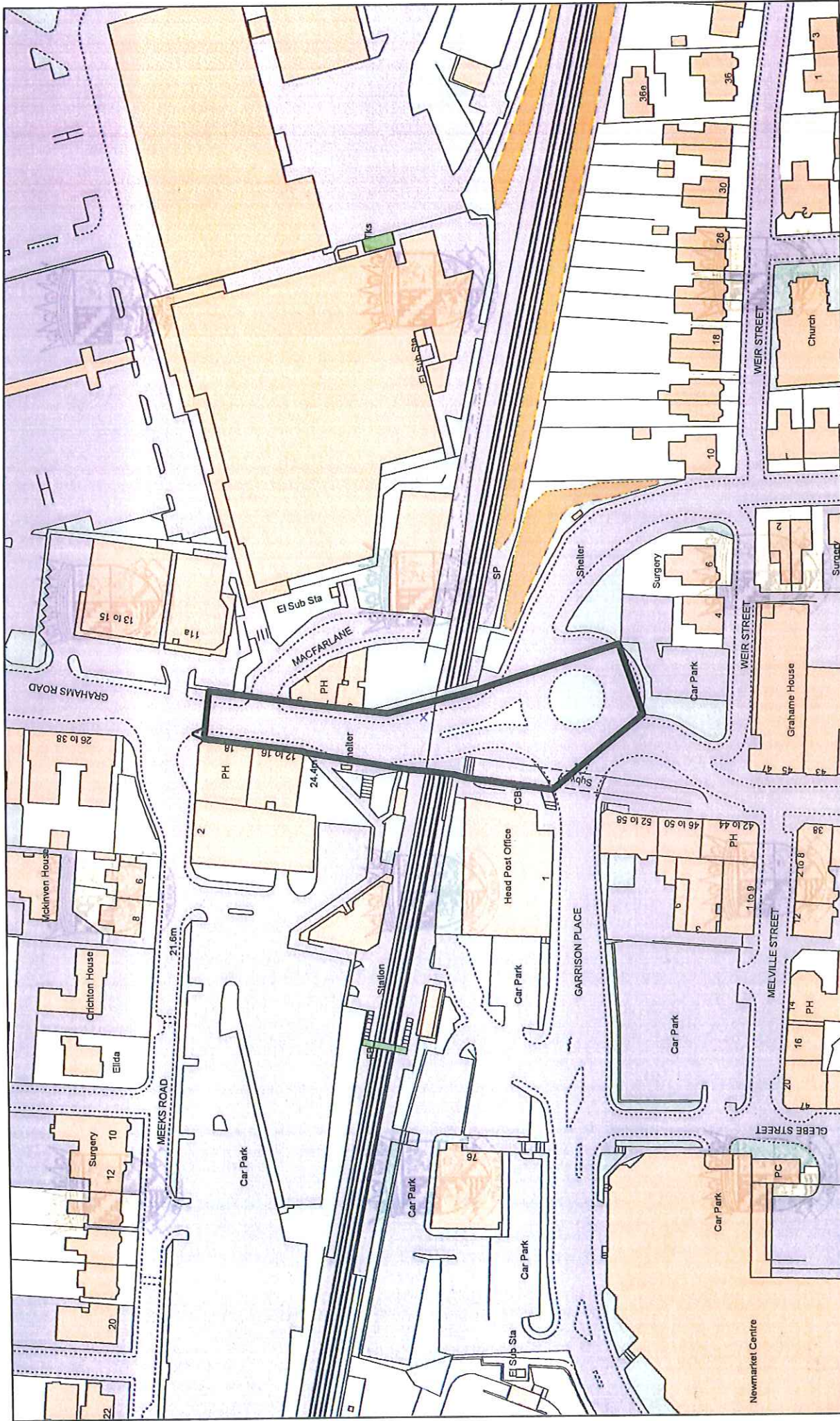
The designated area is designated in relation to a potential breach of the nitrogen dioxide (hourly mean) objective as specified in the Air Quality (Scotland) Regulations 2000. The designated area encompasses a small part of Falkirk Town Centre around Grahams Road. The map can be viewed at i.) Abbotsford House, Falkirk, ii.) Municipal Buildings, Falkirk or iii.) on the Council's website.

The Order shall remain in force until it is varied or revoked by a subsequent Order as described in Section 83(2) of the Environment Act 1995.
